Organization Profile: Opened in 1976 as the Bicentennial project of the State of Wisconsin, **Old World Wisconsin** is the largest ethnic living history museum in the United States. Sprawling over 576 wooded, rolling acres, the museum exhibits more than 50,000 artifacts and 67 historic buildings that have been moved to Old World Wisconsin and restored to their original appearance. Old World Wisconsin educates, researches, and preserves the collection that tells the history of the lives of the ethnic peoples who settled in the state and made Wisconsin the most ethnic state in America from the mid-1800s to the turn of the century. Guides in period clothing make history come alive in the farmhouses, barns, village homes and shops. **Old World Wisconsin Foundation Inc.**, a "Section 501 (c) (3)" corporation not affiliated with the State of Wisconsin, is the principal volunteer fund raising organization for Old World Wisconsin. The organization's IRS 990 report is located on the web site. There are 5 employees who support a budget of \$500,000 through 1 million dollars.

Job Overview: This is a full-time position with two direct reports and is responsible for coordination of volunteer involvement in a comprehensive development program. Responsibilities include membership program and donor acquisition management.

Job Qualifications: Minimum of five years development experience including special events, annual campaign, planned gifts, and major gifts management. Knowledge of the Axelrod method and holding a CFRE is a plus.
